## FAQ's

### **1. Why does the link say virtual college fairs if I'm attending an in-person fair?**

Don't worry – this link was created last year when we only had virtual college fairs, but it will work just as well for the in-person events.

### **2. I registered last year for the virtual fair. Do I have to do it again?**

If you are already registered on our site, you do not have to do it again, but you might have to go into your profile and make any changes from last year (for example, your first and last names now have to be on two different lines, you may have a new phone number or have transferred to a different school).

### **3. I don't remember my login email or password from last year. What can I do?**

If you don't remember the email you used last year, enter the one you mostly use and see if you get a message that you're already registered. You can always re-register with a different email too. If you forgot your password, just click on "Forgot Password" and you will be able to reset it.

### **4. Which email should I use if I have more than one?**

You can select whichever email you want to use on this site. Remember that if you use a school email it will no longer work once you graduate. Pick an email that you use most often, since colleges will be contacting you on the information you provide.

### **5. I'm not sure where I want to apply or what I want to study yet. What should I input in the 'Set Preference' page?**

It's OK if you don't know where and what to study yet! Just make a broad selection or pick something that sounds interesting to you now. These fields are just to make a good match between you and the many colleges at the fair, and you can always change your selections later.

### **6. I don't have a phone or other device I can use at the fair. What should I do?**

Students can register themselves by going to the Registration Link anytime before the fair starts. You can register on a home or school computer, a phone, tablet, or even a friend's phone. If you won't have your device with you at the fair, make sure you **PRINT out the QR code** that you will get at the end of registration. If you do have a phone but the internet is weak, please take a screenshot of your QR code the first time you login so you can save it to your photos. You can show the colleges this code when you go to the fair so that you won't have to write down your information over and over.

### **7. What should I do on the day of the fair?**

On the day of your fair, make sure you LOGIN to your account and open your PROFILE so you can see the QR code (or remember to bring your print-out). You will have between 45 minutes to 1 hour to visit the colleges, so make sure you check out as many booths as possible! Come prepared with 3 – 5 questions to ask each college, and save everything on their tables in your yellow bag. The day after the fair, you will get an email with all the contacts you made, so you can follow up later. But most importantly, HAVE FUN and learn as much as you can about the options open to you!
