Requirements:

- Maximum of two submissions per student
- Maximum word count is 1900 words per submission
- Not previously published online
- Work is entirely the student's own, unassisted
- Each submission must be **printed** one-sided
- No student name, school name, or teacher name on printed submission
- Each submission must be accompanied by a completed entry form (except District Level Admin blank)
- Printed work and completed entry form due to your ELA teacher by **4:15pm** Thursday, February 2nd.

Submissions:

- Short stories
- Poetry
- Essays
- Literary criticism/analysis

- Journalism
- Academic research reports
- Personal narratives
- Any other original student writing

Evaluation guidelines:

Expression of Ideas

- Writing suggests/conveys meanings; reflects strong thinking
- Thematic meaning(s) effectively controlled
- Piece is unified and builds upon itself, even if the structure is untraditional
- Sense of clarity of purpose, completeness, and closure

Language Use

- Writing style appropriate to content and genre
- Writing reflects mastery of technical aspects of writing (e.g., control over punctuation and syntax)
- Writer uses language powerfully, via apt/original word choice, unique phrasing
- Strong flow produced via syntactical control and variation
- · Writer effectively employs detail, evocative language, and/or imagery to enliven writing and to express ideas

Unique Perspective and Voice

- Uniqueness of writer is evident through stylistic choices
- Writing conveys unique, authentic, original perspective
- · Style conveys unique, authentic, original voice
