FAQs

Can my student come in a tutor/study with a friend on their non-pathway Flex Friday?

Yes! There are certain locations in the building that are available for collaborative study and quiet study throughout the day for non-pathway students.

My student wants to sign up for a specific workshop, however it fills up quickly.

Each workshop has a cap based on supplies, number of teachers running the session and capacity of the room. We run most workshops during the morning and afternoon sessions, creating two chances to take that session on a given Friday. If a student does not get their desired session, it will be offered again on their next pathway Flex Friday. Moving forward, registration will be open on Mondays so if a student is desiring a certain session, they can log in on Monday and request that workshop.

If my student is taking two pathways (a major and a minor), what are the requirements?

Students are required to attend the workshops for the major pathway only. Students are more than welcome to attend their minor pathway days to learn about what they decided to minor in but will not count toward their required workshops.

If a student has an excused absence on a Flex Friday, how can they make up their session credits needed?

Students will have several pathway enrichment opportunities throughout the semester that will count towards their credits. This is not meant to punitive in any way. We are going to do whatever we can to encourage active participation in their pathway.
