9TH GRADE

Students will take GT block

 Can start the application for dual enrollment during 9th grade, but can not officially be accepted until they have completed 9th grade.

Once accepted, they take an exemption exam (\$50) for **Gwinnett Tech ALHS 1040** - Introduction to Healthcare (GT block).



10TH GRADE

Students will take Essentials to Healthcare

with one of our teachers who is an adjunct through Gwinnett Tech.

They will receive credit for **Gwinnett Tech ALHS 1011** - Essentials to Healthcare/Structure and function of the Human body.



11TH GRADE



 - (*can take med term as a virtual class through GT spring semester)



Long-term vision is for internships for Juniors and Seniors to be managed through WBL







- Students will now be setting up ACEMAPP accounts
- Once ACEMAPP applications are complete, we will cross-reference list of available shadowing opportunities with seniors and their areas of interest
- Once seniors placed, we will look at current Juniors in the same fashion
- Looking forward, we urge current Juniors to register for work-based learning for Senior year for internships




