

Honor Cords

Summa Cum Laude: GPA 100 or higher Magna Cum Laude: GPA 96 – 99.99 Cum Laude: GPA 88 – 95.99

Honor graduates are distinguished by wearing honor cords at the commencement. This is based on your cumulative average at the end of Fall 2023 semester. There is no rounding up to reach the minimum average. **The cords are optional and cost \$20. You will receive an email with instructions on how to place your order. The window to order cords will be February 1st-15th and you must order your cords in this window.** Once purchased, students will receive their honor cords at graduation practice. Please confirm eligibility for an honor cord by checking the graduate's Cumulative Weighted GPA before purchasing online. Your Cumulative Weighted GPA can be found in Infinite Campus on the student's transcript. **Students that purchase an honor cord and that are ineligible will not be issued an honor cord and will not receive a refund. Other approved cords and pins will be ordered through your club sponsor.**
